



Advancement to a 100-Level Official

In order to be considered for promotion to a 100-level official, the official must:

1. Submit a written request to the EFOA Board of Directors (see link below) requesting consideration for advancement. You must specify the position for which you wish to be considered.
2. Submit a current RTO evaluation with a "Post Season" result.
NOTE: If a new RTO is needed, the second varsity game of the season is the latest an official can be evaluated to be considered for the current season.
3. Score at least 70% on an open book test derived from the NFHS case book.
4. Participate in an interview with the EFOA Board of Directors.

Final advancement will be subject to the approval of the EFOA Board of Directors. At the conclusion of the evaluation, the Board of Directors will inform the official of the promotion or the reason(s) why the promotion was not approved.
