

Post Scrimmage Kick Foul (PSK)

PSK is a fancy way of saying: If 'all of these conditions are true' then the basic spot for penalty enforcement is where the kick ended. Make sure there's a bean-bag where the kick ended!

During a scrimmage kick that does not score:

- The ball is snapped and kicked *PSK only occurs in the box* The ball will or the ball has crossed the expanded neutral zone
 R commits a foul (other than illegal substitution or participation) beyond the expanded neutral zone
 - 4. The kick ends
 - 5. The ball becomes dead (R possesses or ball goes out of bounds)
 - 6. R will be next to put the ball into play

Apply the All-But-One principal: The basic spot is where the kick ends when R

commits a PSK foul (a foul in the box). R fouls behind the PSK spot are spot fouls.
